



NUCO - 1 DAY FIRST AID APPOINTED PERSON

Course Information

Who is the course for?

A minimum six-hour programme (one day) for those who wish to gain knowledge of emergency procedures and attain a recognised qualification in First Aid. Suitable for low risk environments. Candidates get a certificate of attendance as opposed to having to pass a test as for the 4 day course.

The Health & Safety First Aid Regulations 1991 place a responsibility on the employer to provide adequate cover for first aid at work.

What experience do I need?

No experience is needed because all training will be provided.

How long is the course?

One day.

How many people can attend the course?

8- 10 people can attend.

What equipment or machinery will I need to provide?

No equipment will be needed from you.

What facilities will be needed for the training?

A classroom will be required for the course theory that can comfortably seat the number of candidates attending and appropriate refreshment & rest facilities. Power point for laptop – assessor will bring his own laptop and projector.

Can I claim grant?

Company's who are registered with the CITB may be able to claim grant for the completion of this training if it has been included in a planned and approved training plan.

What is the training outcome?

By the end of the course, candidates will be able to demonstrate the essential knowledge and skills needed with threatening emergencies in the workplace.

The course tutor will arrange an on-going assessment and successful students will receive a certificate recognised by the Health and Safety Executive - valid for a period of three years.

When I've completed the training and/or assessment is there anything else I need to do?

The qualification issued is valid for 3 years. This course will need to be re-done when it expires.
